DISTRICT DESCRIPTION: The District has approximately 560 students and is located in Saint Joseph County in Southwest Michigan, 41 miles southeast of Kalamazoo, Michigan and 28 miles southwest of Battle Creek, Michigan. The district houses a kindergarten through 5th grade elementary building, 6th through 12th grade secondary building and kindergarten through 8th grade building primarily serving the Amish families of the region. 10% of our students qualify for special education services. 60% of our students qualify for free or reduced breakfast and lunch. Our students come to us from families with a large diversity in income earnings and job types.

- Assign and grade class work, homework, tests and assignments.
