Position Title: Music Assistant (6th Grade - 12th Grade)

Position Summary

We are seeking an enthusiastic, dependable, and musically skilled **Music Assistant** to support our music education program. This position works closely with the music teaching staff to provide instructional assistance during band and orchestra classes, support rehearsals and performances, and help foster a positive learning environment for students.

Please note: This position is employed through **EduStaff** at a daily rate of \$150. The selected candidate will complete the hiring process and be employed by EduStaff while serving in this role within our music program.

Primary Responsibilities

- Assist music teaching staff with beginning and intermediate band instrument instruction (6th Grade) during classes.
- Support the high school marching band program during rehearsals, performances, competitions, and other related activities.
- Assist with middle school orchestra instruction, rehearsals, and classroom management.
- Provide small-group and one-on-one instructional support to students as directed by the music teaching staff.
- Help prepare and organize rehearsal spaces, music, instruments, and equipment.
- Assist with concert, festival, and performance setup and logistics.
- Monitor student participation and reinforce classroom expectations.
- Perform other duties as assigned in support of the music education program.

Qualifications

- Experience playing and/or teaching band or orchestra instruments.
- Knowledge of instrumental music techniques and ensemble performance practices.
- Ability to work effectively with middle and high school students.
- Strong communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to collaborate as part of a teaching team.
