Personal Qualifications:

Plymouth Christian Academy is seeking a full-time Band Director.

The qualified individual is expected to demonstrate patience, humility, integrity, and kindness while performing his or her daily duties.

Position Summary:

This position is responsible for teaching instrumental music to 5th through 12th grade students. The Band Director will encourage students to develop their instrumental music capability, provide exposure to an enhanced appreciation for music, and support their development of increased self-esteem through participation in rehearsals and performances.

Qualifications:

- 1. Valid Michigan Teacher Certification to teach all levels of Instrumental Music
- **2.** Must demonstrate strong interpersonal and communication skills to develop relationships with administrators, staff, parents and students.

Job Responsibilities:

- 1. Communicate with the student body and encourage participation in band activities.
- 2. Plan, rehearse and direct musical experiences for the school and community with a minimum of two evening performances per school year.
- 3. Collaborate with the school administration in providing music prorams for school productions, graduation ceremonies, and functions that enhance the students' performance experience.
- 4. Lead planning and scheduling of rehearsals and concerts in cooperation with the Superintendant.



5. Supervise all students participating in band activities during all times of involvement.
